Overall job objective:

To provide safe and effective anaesthesia services to patients undergoing surgical and other medical procedures. This includes preoperative assessment, administering anaesthesia, monitoring patients during procedures, and providing post-operative care

Functional Outputs/Activities per key performance area:

Equipment Maintenance and Supplies

Oversee the safe functioning of the anesthesia machine, oxygen supply, suction, and all equipment necessary to provide anesthesia in close consultation with the biomedical team.

Ensure adequate restocking of anesthesia supplies in collaboration with the Anesthetic Officer.

Preoperative Assessment

Complete preoperative anesthesia evaluations of patients and order necessary lab work/consultation, or any other preoperative investigations.

Review preoperative patient charts for pertinent lab work, history and physical, vital sign chart, fluid status, and medication sheet.

Assess patient risk factors and determine the most appropriate anesthesia technique.

Counsel patients and their families regarding anesthesia risks and benefits.

Obtain informed consent for anesthesia procedures.

Anesthesia Administration:

Perform induction, maintenance & emergence of general anesthesia.

Manage the patient airway adequately utilizing the mask, bag-valve mask, intubation, LMA, and other emergency airway procedures.
Administer anesthesia safely and effectively, including general, regional, and local anesthesia.
Utilize appropriate monitors and monitor patients intra-operatively.
Manage airway and ventilation during surgery.
Respond to emergencies and complications that may arise during anesthesia.
Accurately manage fluid resuscitation in the patient.

Postoperative Care:

Monitor patients in the recovery room until they are stable for transfer to the ward.
Manage pain and discomfort postoperatively.
Provide instructions to patients and their families regarding post-operative care.

Quality Improvement:

Participate in quality improvement initiatives to enhance patient safety and outcomes.
Adhere to hospital policies and procedures related to anesthesia and patient care.
Stay updated on the latest advancements in anesthesia techniques and technologies

Teamwork and Collaboration:

Work collaboratively with surgeons, nurses, and other healthcare professionals to ensure optimal patient care.
Participate in the training and education of junior staff.

Documentation:

Maintain accurate and complete medical records, including preoperative assessments, anesthesia records, and postoperative notes.
Accurate client records are maintained in both the client record book and daily register.
Ensure all client information is always kept confidential and stored appropriately.
Accurate and timely collation of activity data for internal and external reporting purposes.

Financial Management

Ensuring adherence to the unit budget to ensure optimal use of resources
Monitors equipment functioning, service & reports malfunctioning equipment

Evaluating the patient's medical history, the potential benefits of the procedure, and the associated risks
